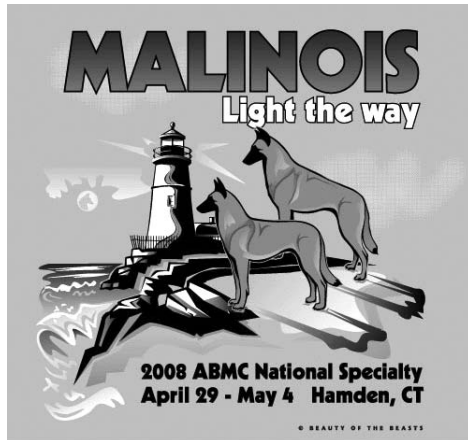

Bear left at 2nd stop sign (still route 87). Then go one mile to the second left on to Oliver Road. First driveway on the left, #33, black mailbox.

From Rte 2 East: Take Exit 13 to route 66 east through Columbia center (approximate 10 miles). Turn right on to 87 south and go 4.6 miles (at 0.3 miles after Log Cabin Restaurant). Turn right on to Oliver Road. First driveway on left, #33, black mailbox.

Entry Information

- The American Belgian Malinois Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
- Entries must be received by Wednesday, March 26, 2008, 6:00PM EST after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 8 of the dog show rules. Entries may be made online. Please see page 2 for more information. No telephone, verbal or E-mail entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing. E-mail for changes is acceptable prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.
- Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts with 9 digit ABA routing numbers or with international money orders in US funds or by major credit card. See page 2 for more information.
- There will be no refunds for duplicate entries

- All entries must be on official AKC herding entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, or are submitted with incorrect fees.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club will add a collection fee to the amount of the check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by any reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or it's superintendent.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be excepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- A dog may be entered in both a Trial class and a Test class for a given trial. However, one entry should be designated the priority entry on the entry form should the entry limits be reached. The second entry will be then taken as an alternate.
- Members of the American Belgian Malinois Club, the Trial Secretary, Starshine Farm, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, death of any animal, or the loss of or damage to any property while at these shows/trials or on the show/trial grounds, or in transit to or from the site. The ABMC furthermore assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- By entering this show, exhibitors and agents agree to maintain orderly conditions. Any arguing or abusive language may result in forfeiture of all privileges, without refund of fees. Such actions may be subject to disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. ABMC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against ABMC or official thereof.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor is superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.**
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All trophies and prizes must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen, and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced.
- Loss or Damage – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor/parent. It is distinctly understood that the exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over children on the day of the shows **OR THE EXHIBITOR/PARENT WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES.**

- Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by the Show Committee. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstances, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited. If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked vehicle on the show grounds or in the parking areas, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.
- There will be absolutely no dumping of gray water from your RV onto the ground.
- Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming area, parking area, hotel grounds and hotel room.
- **Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.** Exhibitors and handlers must pick up fecal matter deposited by their dogs on the grounds, streets, sidewalks, and parking lots.
- No smoking will be allowed or tolerated in any building on the show site. Offenders of the rule shall be subject to a fine and will be asked to leave.
- **These rules will be enforced by the show committee. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the show committee.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- All rights to televise, videotape, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit these events are vested in the club or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the shows are in progress, by attending these shows or participating therein, hereby grant to the clubs the right to photograph, televise, videotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
